

NIGHTTIME CONSTRUCTION ALONG HWY 43

In early November, night crews will begin installing about two miles of large diameter pipeline along Highway 43, from Laurel Street in Lake Oswego to Mapleton Drive in West Linn. To help complete the work as quickly as possible, two crews will be operating, one working south from Lake Oswego towards West Linn, and the other working north from West Linn towards Lake Oswego.



To increase safety while minimizing the impacts to businesses and traffic, work will occur Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. No construction activities are scheduled between 5 a.m. on Friday through 8 p.m. on Sunday or on legal holidays.

In most areas, one lane of traffic will be open in each direction. In some narrow areas, one lane will be open at a time with flaggers guiding traffic in each direction. All travel lanes will be open during the day.

Prior to the pipe installation, portions of the roadway where the pipe will be placed will be saw-cut. To help minimize noise impacts, these portions will be cut from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. in short durations.
